### The 28th Asia Pacific Area Convention

Y's Men International, 28<sup>th</sup> Asia Pacific Area Convention was held at Sendai International Center from 19<sup>th</sup> July to 21<sup>st</sup>. ACTION! Let's move on! was the theme of the Convention, wishing each participant to think and take actions for support and reconstruction of the great East Japan Earthquake.

The beautiful voices of Sendai Minami High School filled the venue and AP Hiroyuki Tanaka declared the Opening. Then the Installation of IP Jennifer Jones was led by Mr. Hirotoshi Fujii, PIP and Inaugural address was given by Ms Jones.

Mr. Yoshihiro Murai, Governor of Miyagi gave the keynote speech on "Future of Reconstruction and Disaster Prevention. Then Ms. Nobue Kunizaki, President, the Crisis Management Research Institute, mentioned the importance of habit of preparing for disaster. Then Y's and YMCA hour followed. Mr. Nobuo Murai, General Secretary of Sendai YMCA and Mr. Hisao Mitsunaga, Secretary of National Council of YMCAs Japan gave the reports of Assistance and Relief Work.

IPAP Night started with Mini Concert by Mr. Muneyuki Sato who enchanted all the audience. Second Day was Excursion and we are so grateful for the committee who prepared 21 buses and selecting 4 courses which covered the theme of the Convention. Over 750 participants were impressed and moved deeply by what they have seen and learned the reality of the disaster. AP Night was welcomed by AP Tanaka and music by Mossy Jazz Orchestra. Performance by the Youth was impressive and AP Culture Night started. At the end Japan East Region group sang the Hanawasaku,( Flowers bloom), the theme song for the recovering from devastated disaster.

Third day started by the Morning Service, the sermon by Rev. Hiroyuki Shibuya and the offering was donated for the scholarship for the youth in Sendai.

The promotion of the next Convention in Kaohsung and the 74<sup>th</sup> IC, in Odense Denmark was announced. IP Tanaka proudly declared the closing the Convention.
